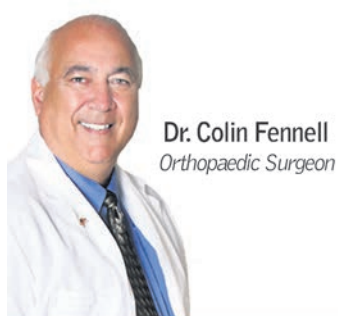

Flooding ... Marshall County gets emergency state aid

Gov. Mark Dayton has authorized the use of funds from the State Disaster Assistance Contingency Account for emergency relief in Lac qui Parle and Marshall counties on Wednesday, May 30.

Areas of each county experienced significant damage to public properties caused by severe spring flooding brought on by melting snow. Flooding began April 21 and lasted through May 17.

Marshall County received \$141,289, and Lac qui Parle County received \$51,177. Aid from the Contingency Account will reimburse counties for public infrastructure repairs and clean-up costs. Under Minnesota law, the state will reimburse 75 percent of eligible costs for public infrastructure repairs and clean-up, with local governments responsible for covering the remaining 25 percent.

Candidates file for office

Candidates to prepare for Aug. 14 primary

Residents have put their hats in the ring for county and state elective office. The primary election will be held Tuesday, Aug. 14. The general election will be held Tuesday, Nov. 6. The following candidates have filed as noted on the Minnesota Secretary of State's website.

State representative

The seats of state representative for Districts 1A

and 1B will be on the ballot this fall. Incumbent Dan Fabian (R-Roseau) and Steve Moeller (DFL-Thief River Falls) have filed for the District 1A seat. Incumbent Deb Kiel (R-Crookston) and Brent Lindstrom (DFL-East Grand Forks) have filed for the District 1B seat.

Kittson County

Two county commissioner seats, Districts 3 and 5, will be on the ballot in Kittson County. James H. Johnson and Loren Younggren have filed for the District 3 seat. Alex J. Gustafson, George Hanson and Darrel Johnson have filed for the District 5 seat.

Steve Porter, who is serving as sheriff, has filed for that position as has Mark

Wilwant. Robert Albrecht filed for county attorney. Andrew Muir has filed for the District 3 soil and water supervisor seat. Samuel R. Anderson has filed for the District 4 soil and water supervisor seat.

Marshall County

Two county commissioner seats, Districts 1 and 5, will be on the ballot this fall in Marshall County. Dave Conely and Jim Duckstad have filed for the District 1 seat. Incumbent Gary Kiesow faces no opposition for the District 5 seat.

Six other candidates face no opposition. They include Sheriff Jason Boman, County Attorney Donald Aandal, Auditor/Treasurer Scott Peters, and soil and

water supervisor candidates Duane Potucek (incumbent, District 3), Wallace Bengtson (incumbent, District 4) and Bradley Berg (incumbent, District 5).

Pennington County

Two county commissioner seats, Districts 3 and 4, will be on the ballot in Pennington County. Incumbent Neil Peterson will face opposition from David A. Bach for the District 3 position. Incumbent Darryl Tveitbakk faces no opposition for the District 4 seat.

Six other candidates face no opposition - Sheriff Ray Kuznia; County Attorney Seamus Duffy, who was appointed earlier this year; Auditor/Treasurer Kenneth "Terry" Olson; Recorder

Julie Hansen; and soil and water supervisor candidates Ricky A. Peterson (incumbent, District 2) and Brenda Szymanski (incumbent, District 3).

Polk County

Two county commissioner seats, Districts 2 and 4, will be on the ballot in Polk County. Incumbent Warren Strandell faces no opposition for the District 2 seat. Dennis R. Boucher and incumbent Joan Lee have filed for the District 4 seat.

The position of sheriff is also on the ballot. Randy Sondrol and Jim Tadman have filed for that position. County Attorney Greg Widseth filed for reelection.

Fence to discourage geese

This spring, Thief River Falls parks maintenance employees installed fences around the beach area at Bill LaFave Park in an attempt to keep geese out of the park. Fencing has also been placed at the edge of the river in Chief Red Robe Park.

Last summer, three water samples collected at the beach were over the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency's acute standard for E. coli, which meant the water was not safe for swimming, wading or other forms of recreation.

The problem was attributed to waste from geese. Low water flow and higher than average temperatures were also a concern. A test conducted for blue green algae came back negative.

Doug Franke, wildlife manager in Thief River Falls

for the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, said he has heard that fencing has been successful in keeping geese out of areas in the state.

Franke said it would be particularly successful for several weeks in June when goslings are incapable of flight and adult geese are going through a molting period, which means they shed their flight feathers for a short period. Adults also won't leave the goslings. It means they can't or won't simply fly over the netting.

Franke said he was consulted by the city. He said it would be interesting to see what happens. He also noted there are several other locations in town where the geese may congregate.

The city has other options. Those options might include trapping, removal and disposal. In those

The beach is open. 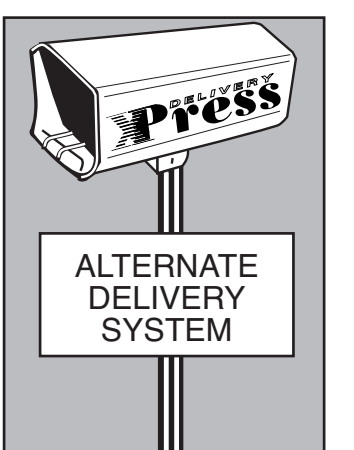

Foresters plant 362,000 trees

Warroad area foresters have been keeping busy this spring with a number of missions.

Spring tree planting in the area involved planting 362,000 trees across 488 acres this spring. Trees consisted primarily of jack pine with smaller amounts of red pine, spruce, and white pine mixed in across the forest. Members of the contract planting crew averaged 3,000 trees per day per person. Planting was mainly in the Beltrami Island State Forest.

A total of 149 acres were aerial seeding this spring in the forest. Of these, 137 acres were beetle-damaged tamarack that was salvaged as fuelwood, and the land was seeded back to a mix of tamarack and spruce.

Foresters were also working on finishing 3,500 acres of regeneration; surveys need to be completed by the end of the spring. Surveys are typically conducted systematically at years one, three and five following timber harvest to ensure there are enough trees present to establish and develop a new stand.

The last month has also been busy in terms of wild-fire suppression. Local fire departments and forestry staff have combined to suppress 62 wildfires totaling 6,465 acres in the Warroad area (Roseau, Kittson, Marshall, Pennington, northwest Beltrami and western Lake of the Woods counties). The County Road 7 Fire in

northwest Roseau County has accounted for 3,500 of the total acreage. Greenbush, Lancaster, Lake Bronson and Karlstad fire departments, along with the Department of Natural Resources and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, responded to this fire. The recent rains and green-up have helped to lower the fire danger in the area; however, the DNR encourages folks to use caution and have good breaks in place to prevent fire escapes. Remember to obtain a burning permit and activate each day you burn.

Road restrictions were lifted in the state forest on Thursday, May 17. Forest roads are open with the exception of a few trails that are currently under repair. See the DNR website at www.dnr.state.mn.us/trail-conditions/listing.html for the latest on forest road and trail status.

Prepare for a summer around the water

For many children, summer fun is often equated with the amount of time spent at the beach or in a swimming pool. The challenge for parents will be finding the time to get their children to the pool or beach and making sure their children are prepared for that kind of activity. Please begin by making sure your child has successfully passed swimming lessons. It isn't the responsibility of lifeguards to teach children how to swim. It is their responsibility to monitor the activities at

the beach or swimming pool and prevent injury or accidental drownings. It's the responsibility of parents to make sure their children receive and successfully pass swim lessons from a certified instructor. Maybe the best place to start is with the swimming lesson classes offered through the Community Education Department of School District 564.

From 2005 to 2014, there were an average of 3,536 fatal unintentional drownings in the U.S. - about 10 per day. About one in five people who die from drowning are children 14 and younger.

Support exists for veterans accused or convicted of a crime

Jual Carlson of Karlstad recently shared with The Times and Northern Watch information that might assist a veteran following conviction of a crime.

According to Carlson, legislation enacted in August 2008 requires the court to determine if a defendant has recent deployment history or is a veteran of any war - following conviction of a crime. This law is an effort to promote veterans' use of an array of services that may be available through the Veteran's Administration, including veterans' benefits and mental health services. The text of Minnesota Statutes 609.115 is as follows:

(a) When a defendant appears in court and is convicted of a crime, the court shall inquire whether the defendant is currently serving in or is a veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States.

(b) If the defendant is currently serving in the military or is a veteran and has been diagnosed as having a mental illness by a qualified psychiatrist or clinical psychologist or physician, the court may:

(1) order that the officer preparing the report under subdivision 1 consult with the U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs, Minnesota Department of Veterans Affairs, or another agency or person with suitable knowl-

edge or experience, for the purpose of providing the court with information regarding treatment options available to the defendant, including federal, state and local programming; and

(2) consider the treatment recommendations of any diagnosing or treating mental health professionals together with the treatment options available to the defendant in imposing sentence.

Carlson advised that if the defendant is an active service member or a veteran, to inform the court administration staff when they check in for court, or inform the judge at the time the case is called in the courtroom.

Take a Kid Fishing this weekend

On Take a Kid Fishing Weekend from Friday, June 8, to Sunday, June 10, Minnesotans can fish without licenses if they take children 15 or younger fishing, according to the Department of Natural Resources.

"Fishing together with kids can be a great way to enjoy the outdoors and have some memorable experiences," said Jeff Ledermann, DNR angler recruitment, retention and education supervisor. "We encourage people to give it a try. It's fairly easy to buy or borrow fishing poles, and one good way to start is by fishing for bluegills with small hooks, bobbers and live bait."

Minnesotans 15 and younger don't need fishing licenses any time of the year. Take a Kid Fishing Weekend is a way for adults and kids to fish together without the step of buying a license.

The DNR's Take a Kid Fishing Weekend page at mndnr.gov/takeakidfishing includes links to a beginner's guide to fishing; DNR's Fish Minnesota page that includes regulations and locations of easy-to-access fishing piers and shorefishing areas; and information about fishing in Minnesota state parks.

Fishing gear is available to borrow at state parks and the DNR's I Can Fish! program teaches the basics of fishing and runs throughout the summer at state parks. Even when it's not Take a Kid Fishing Weekend, Minnesota residents generally can fish in state parks without a fishing license if the body of water does not require a trout stamp.

Tennis program makes history

TRF boys tennis team is Class A runner-up

From 2004-2014, the Thief River Falls boys tennis team won the Section 8A championship every year. During that 11-season span, the Prowlers' highest finish was third in 2010.

A private school has won the Class A state championship each year since 1992 and most state tournament teams from Thief River Falls would only advance until facing a private school, which was the case in 2010 when the Prowlers fell 7-0 to the Blake School in the semifinals, only to rally for a 4-3 win over Virginia in the third place match.

The Class AA state tournament bracket is now seeded, but the Class A bracket still uses a random draw. The 2018 draw was more than favorable for the Prowlers who were on the opposite side of the bracket from the top two teams in the state - Rochester Lourdes and St. Peter - coupled with the fact that the Blake School is now in Class AA and Breck is down this year and didn't make it out of sections.

Thief River Falls opened the tournament with a hard fought 4-3 win against a more experienced Luverne team. As has been the case

all post season, Thief River Falls was the first to post a match victory as Carter Onkka bageled Cade VerSteege 6-0, 6-0 in the number two singles match.

Luverne got on the board with a win in number one doubles to even the match at one win a piece, and added a win at three singles by Jim Erickson over Tucker Skime to take a 2-1 lead in the dual.

Thief River Falls picked up a win from Ethan Janisch and Aiden Martell at number three doubles to tie the dual 2-2, and went back in front 3-2 on a Camden Broadwell win over Trey Baustain at four singles.

Mark Robinson of Luverne knocked off Cole Gillespie 7-6 (7-3), 6-4 to claim the number one singles match and tie the dual 3-3.

With the match on the line, the Prowlers turned to the number two doubles team of Noah Rupprecht and Dylan Hahn. Two weeks after coming from behind to win their match and clinch a section title, Hahn and Rupprecht won the clinching points again knocking off Cole Stoltenberg and Ethan Thorson 7-6 (7-1), 6-4.

"Against Luverne, I went up to my partner, Dylan, and said it's 3-3, but I didn't re-

ally know that. I was kind of messing with him," Rupprecht said. "When the crowd started cheering like crazy we figured out that was 3-3 and that we gotta win this."

The semifinal match against Litchfield had a similar feel. The Prowlers won 5-2 but at one point looked like it was going to be a 4-3 win for the Dragons rather than a win for the Prowlers.

Litchfield got on the board first with wins in the number one doubles spot and number three singles.

Carter Onkka won the first set with relative ease, 6-2, and overcame a 5-1 deficit in the second to win 7-5 and put the Prowlers on the board.

"I thought I played a pretty clean first set," Carter Onkka said. "Second set, I was missing balls that I should be hitting in. I just tried to tighten it up, maybe give myself a little more room when I'm going for shots."

Two minutes later, Janisch and Martell won the number three doubles match to tie the dual 2-2.

Camden Broadwell won 6-3, 6-4 over Griffin Kinny in four singles to put the Prowlers up 3-2 in the dual.

The two remaining matches were each heading for a third set. In one singles, Cole Gillespie had dropped the first set 4-6, but rallied to win the second set 6-4. In two doubles, the opposite happened as Hahn/Rupprecht won the first set 6-2 and lost the second 4-6.

"We just needed to stay calm and not get down on each other," Rupprecht said.

After having lost the momentum in the second set, Hahn/Rupprecht took charge in the third set, winning 6-1 to clinch the Prowlers' first ever appearance in the state title match.

Gillespie kept his momentum going in the one singles match and claimed the third set 6-1 to defeat Trevor Meyer and give the Prowlers

a 5-2 win in the dual.

Thief River Falls gave its best effort in the state championship match and its best wasn't enough against top-ranked Rochester Lourdes, which surrendered just 14 games in its six wins during the dual.

The Prowlers' lone win came at three doubles, with Janisch/Martell improving to 3-0 on the weekend with a 6-2, 7-5 win over Birch Lewis/Yisrael Morris.

Team captain Carter Onkka said his team came to compete for the state title. While the loss is disappointing, he said the team gave its best effort.

"It was exciting - state championship, that's what we play for," Carter Onkka said. "We knew they were good, but we're here too, so let's show them how we can play."

With the team portion of

the competition in the books, Onkka and Gillespie moved on to doubles competition Thursday morning. Results from the state doubles tournament will appear in The Times.

(Continued from Page 1) tour group also had breakfast at the farm – with milk.

Before long, the kindergartners moved between stations. At their first station, Kim Bauer and Kelsie Hagen's kindergartners learned the calves are fed two to three times a day. They also learned the cows eat grain, protein and hay. The heifers eat oat hay to ensure their stomachs are full.

"We milk two times a day," said Ryan. "Some farms milk three times a day."

When they weren't busy listening to Ryan's presentation, some of the kids were giving attention to T Rex, a cat who lives on the Griffin farm.

A short time later, the two classes watched as Ryan milked Gigi with an auto-

matic milking machine. As Gigi stood in the milking stall, the kids petted her side.

Bauer's class soon moved on to see the calves. They met Shamrock, a red and white Holstein. "She was born just after St. Patrick's Day," said Karen, who noted the calf was recently dehorned. Shamrock was more than willing to check out the kids and let them pet her.

Nearby pens contained Snow Melt, a calf born in mid-April, and an as-yet-unnamed calf born four days before the tour.

The kids learned that the Griffins try to make the pens as comfortable as possible for the calves, placing a fan nearby and wood shavings on the floor.

Before long, Karen took the students to meet goats Luke and Leia whose mom

isn't Padme. Her name is Twinkle Toes. "Where's Luke's lightsaber?" one student asked.

The chicken coop is adjacent to the goat area. Unlike the rest of the Griffin animal clan, the seven laying hens are unnamed and collectively known as "the chickens." Karen fed them some old hot dog buns. Much to the kids' dismay, they didn't get a chance to feed or hold the hens themselves. However, they learned about eggs. "These chickens lay tan eggs," said Karen, who noted that eggs can also be speckled, light blue or light green in addition to white.

Bauer's class soon moved to the gardening station, where they learned about vegetables from Pennington County Master Gardeners Kathy Carlson and Beattie Mickelson. There, Carlson

handed each student a vegetable and asked them to determine which part of the vegetable plant people eat.

One of the vegetables was the turnip. Carlson asked, "Has anybody eaten turnips?"

"Not me," one student replied.

"Oohh ... they're really good in soup," Carlson said.

Five soil and water supervisor positions will be on the ballot. Incumbent Kenneth Pederson filed for the District 1 (East) seat. Incumbent Mark McWalter filed for the District 1 (West) seat. No one filed for the District 2 (East) seat. Johnathan Sorenson filed for the District 3 (West) seat, and Chris Cournia filed for the District 5 (West) seat. The latter seat is on the ballot as part of a special election.

Red Lake County
Three county commissioner seats, District 1, 3 and 4, will be on the ballot in Red Lake County. None of the candidates face opposition. They include Incumbent Anthony "Chuck" Flage (District 1), Delane "Jim" Dudycha (District 3) and Allen R. Remick (District 4). (Continued from Page 1) instances, the meat is utilized by food shelves. However, Franke said, this option usually generates controversy, and he said, the city has not shown any interest in pursuing this option.

The other issue will be whether the public accepts the fencing. Signs hanging from the fence at the beach explain that the beach is open and asks that the fence be put back in its place if moved to gain access to the water.

Vandalism and whether citizens accept this option will also determine its success.

Franke said he has "not heard anything pro or con

about the fences" from citizens in the community.

A quick survey of goose fencing online shows several options. An advertisement for a retractable Goose D-Fence, stated that researchers have discovered that geese require easy access to food and a drink of water every 30 minutes. It said geese will seek a path of least resistance and move on to other locations that better suit their needs.

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources also points out that energized fencing can effectively and practically reduce goose grazing on yards. "When a goose touches an energized fence, the electric pulse passes from the energizer through the fence wire, through the goose, into

the earth, to the grounding system and back to the energizer. The result is an uncomfortable, but harmless, 'shock' that geese learn to avoid." They also note that energized fencing is prohibited in some cities.

Melissa Sletten, arena manager for the city of Thief River Falls, said that at this point the fencing seems to be working. She said they will be discussing it in the near future. She also added that the water appears very clear and they don't have plans to test the water for E. coli.

Rydell and Glacial Ridge National Wildlife Refuges, in collaboration with the Friends of Rydell and Glacial Ridge Refuges Association, have announced that they will be hosting numerous free public events this summer at the Rydell NWR Visitor Center.

Events that are part of the FRGRRRA's Learning at the Lakes Educational Program will take place from 1 to 3 p.m. Sundays. The first event will be a Creating Habitat for Pollinators activity on Sunday, June 10. Participants will learn about local plants important to pollinators by creating their own "pollinator planter" to take home.

On Sunday, June 17, the Refuge will host an Introduction to Archery activity for youth ages 7 to 15. Instructors will utilize Rydell NWR's new Hoverball Archery System to provide a safe, educational, and fun introduction to this sport.

On Sunday, June 24, an Owl Pellet Discovery activity will provide interested members of the public with the opportunity to work alongside Refuge staff to dissect the digestive discharge (pellet) of an owl. Using sanitized owl pellets, participants will begin to explore the behavior and diet of local owl species.

Kids ages 5 to 12 can also come out to the Refuge to learn all about Minnesota Animal Track Identification by making their own plaster track replicas. This wild event will take place Sunday, July 8.

On Sunday, July 22, children and adults alike are welcome to come build their own bluebird houses. Refuge staff will provide all necessary materials.

The final Learning at the Lakes event will be a Pond Study program Sunday, Aug. 5. Children ages 6 to 12 can sample invertebrate life in Refuge wetlands and examine their findings under Discovery Scopes.

In addition to the Learning at the Lakes activities,

Rydell NWR will host its 3rd Annual Youth Fishing Day on Saturday, July 21 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. This free event is targeted towards youth, age 15 or younger. Fishing equipment (for participants without their own) and bait will be provided, as well as a free lunch and door prizes.

Check out your local library in June, July, and August for a series of "Explore YOUR National Wildlife Refuges" programs. Refuge staff will present these hour-long programs at five area public libraries. These educational programs will include a hands-on component in order to introduce the area public to wildlife viewing and public use opportunities provided at Rydell and Glacial Ridge NWRs. These programs will be held at the Fertile Library on June 29 at 10 a.m., the Crookston Library on July 11 at 1 p.m., the Climax Library on July 12 at 5:30 p.m., the Mahanomen Library on July 27 at 10:30 a.m., and the Ada Library on Aug. 9 at 4 p.m.

Marshall County FSA acreage reporting dates announced

Marshall County Farm Service Agency Executive Director Russell Miller has announced that producers who file accurate and timely reports for all crops and land uses, including failed acreage, can prevent the potential loss of Farm Service Agency program benefits. Pay close attention to the acreage reporting dates below.

"In order to comply with FSA program eligibility requirements, all producers are encouraged to visit the Marshall County FSA office to file an accurate crop certification report by the applicable deadline," said Miller.

The following acreage reporting dates are applicable for Marshall County:

- July 15 - All spring seeded crops and Conservation Reserve Program
- Nov. 15 - All fall seeded crops and perennial forage crops for harvest in 2019.

The following exceptions apply to the above acreage reporting dates:

- If the crop has not been planted by the above acreage reporting date, then

the acreage must be reported no later than 15 calendar days after planting is completed.

- If a producer acquires additional acreage after the above acreage reporting date, then the acreage must be reported no later than 30 calendar days after purchase or acquiring the lease. Appropriate documentation must be provided to the county office.
- If a perennial forage crop is reported with the intended use of "cover only," "green manure," "left standing" or "seed," then the acreage must be reported by Sunday, July 15.

According to Miller, Non-insured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) policy holders should note that the acreage reporting date for NAP-covered crops is the earlier of the dates listed above or 15 calendar days before grazing or harvesting of the crop begins.
