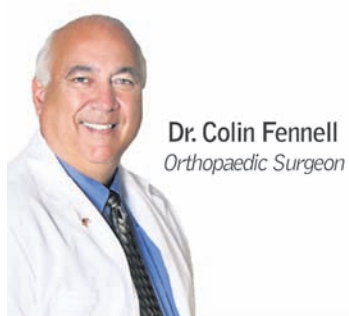

## Moving to the general election

One election is down and another is left to go for some of the candidates who were featured on the primary ballot Tuesday, Aug. 14. The general election will be held Tuesday, Nov. 6.

**U.S. Representative, District 7**  
Dave Hughes (Republican Party) will face incumbent Collin Peterson (Democratic-Farmer-Labor Party) in the race for U.S. representative, District 7. Hughes defeated Matt Prosch by 30,620 to 11,554 votes in the Republican primary. Peterson faced no opposition in the DFL primary.

**U.S. Senator**  
Incumbent Amy Klobuchar (DFL) will face Jim Newberger (R) in the general election. Both won their respective primaries.

**U.S. Senator, special election**  
Tina Smith (DFL) will face Karin Housley (R) for the other U.S. Senate seat in Minnesota. They won their respective primaries.

## Temporary watercraft "no wake" ordinance enacted in TRF area

Ordinance affects tournament

The Pennington County Board has approved a temporary watercraft "no-wake" ordinance on the Thief River from Long's bridge to the countyline. Watercraft are now only allowed to be operated at the "slowest possible speed necessary to maintain steerage, but in no case greater than 5 mph."

The temporary ordinance is in effect immediately and until Thursday, Nov. 1 unless sooner modified. The temporary ordinance was approved to combat the

spread of blue-green algae found in that area. At least two area dogs have died from exposure to blue-green algae.

The Thief River Falls Lions Club Fishing Tournament will be affected by the temporary ordinance. The tournament is set for Saturday, Aug. 18 on the Thief and Red Lake rivers. Over the past couple of weeks, the sheriff's office has been in contact with the Lions Club regarding this change. The organization plans to educate participants on the temporary ordinance. More information on the fishing tournament can be found on the sports page in this newspaper.

Corey Hanson, RLWD water quality coordinator,

previously told the Northern Watch that it should be OK to eat fish from the river as long as fillets are cleaned properly. He reminded anglers and boaters to use caution. Hanson further noted the blue-green algae would get worse as the blooms die and release toxins.

Commissioners approved the temporary ordinance at their meeting Tuesday, Aug. 14. Earlier that morning, as required by state law, County Board held a public hearing to gain public input regarding the temporary ordinance. Sheriff Ray Kuznia, the Red Lake Watershed District and the city of Thief River Falls had requested the temporary ordinance. They indicated that a significant amount of boat traffic

could stir up the blue-green algae and cause it to float downstream into the Red Lake River.

During the public hearing, RLWD Natural Resource Specialist Ashley Hitt reported that a water sample was taken a day earlier from the Thief River at the Thief River Golf Club bridge. She indicated algae was present in the water, but a low concentration of algae was detected. The concentration was too low to cause harm; however, Hitt cautioned commissioners and Kuznia to keep an eye out for blue-green algae blooms. She said the water temperature was 81 degrees Fahrenheit at the time that the sample was collected. Hitt noted that temperature

was outrageous. If the area continues to experience hot temperatures with no rain or water flow, she said it is possible for blue-green algae blooms to appear virtually out of nowhere.

Flow from the Red Lake River is greater than that of the Thief River. Hitt noted that any blue-green algae flowing downstream would dissipate to a lower concentration than concentrations found in the Thief River. The city of Thief River Falls' water intake system is located on the Red Lake River, south of First Street.

Elsewhere in the region, blue-green algae has been detected in Maple and Cameron lakes. Hitt said

**Voyageur George Bonga**  
Also on Aug. 25, Voyageur George Bonga of 1837 will be brought to life by Joel Brown of Mendota. Born in 1802 near what is now Duluth, Bonga was one of the first African-Americans born in what later became the state of Minnesota. His father, Pierre Bonga, was the son of a former slave or servant; his mother was an

Ojibwe. Pierre Bonga was a relatively successful trader, and he sent George to Montreal for school. When he returned to the Great Lakes region, George spoke fluent English, French and Ojibwe. Bonga became a fur trader with the American Fur Company, where he got acquainted with Lewis Cass. Cass hired Bonga as a guide and translator for negotiations with the Ojibwe. Bonga's signature is on treaties brokered in 1820 and 1867.

In 1837, an Ojibwe man named Che-ga-wa-skung was accused of murdering a white man at Cass Lake. The man escaped. According to contemporary accounts, after a posse failed to track down Che-gawa-skung, Bonga headed out in the subzero chill of January. Six days later, he returned with the suspect, tied to a dog sled, and transported him 250 miles to Fort Snelling. In one of the first criminal proceedings in the area, Che-ga-wa-skung was tried and acquitted.

In 1842, Bonga married

### No injuries reported after car collides with semi trailer

No injuries were reported Friday, Aug. 10 after a car collided with a semi trailer and its rear dual wheels in the city of Thief River Falls. The car was then stuck underneath the trailer. At the time of the accident, John Medicraft, 49, Roseau, was driving a car on Highway 32 in Thief River Falls. According to preliminary information from the Minnesota State Patrol,

Medicraft failed to stop for a red stoplight. His car then collided with the semi trailer. Rodney Harder, 53, Thief River Falls, was driving the semi tractor, which was westbound on Greenwood Street. Medicraft has been cited for failure to drive with due care. The State Patrol was dispatched to the scene at about 3:42 p.m. Aug. 10.

To obtain MNSHARP recertification, Minnesota OSHA consultants performed a comprehensive workplace inspection at Central Boiler and reviewed all of its safety and health programs and injury and illness rates. Central Boiler is one of 38 active MNSHARP worksites. This worksite is the location of both Central Boiler, which manufactures outdoor furnaces, and Altoz, which manufactures zero-turn mowers including the industry's first zero-turn mowers with tracks.

### Fire danger remains high in NW Minnesota

It shouldn't take a genius to figure out that fields are a "little" dry. I've avoided using the D word, and most people would only use it after seeing occurrences three years in a row, thus establishing a trend, but there's no question now that northwestern Minnesota is in a drought, even if we've only experienced it for two years. I won't go on about the need for a safety net for farmers. That, too, should be evident. Instead, I'd like to focus on a danger associated with drought - fire. If you'll excuse me for exaggerating a bit: It has been so hot and dry, gardeners are using pot holders to pull cooked potatoes out of the ground. (Sometimes we need a good laugh.)

Seriously though, Adam Munstenteiger, forestry department supervisor for the Min-

nesota Department of Natural Resources in northwestern Minnesota, wrote this past week that the region has received only four inches of moisture in the last two months - several inches less than normal.

Most of us probably saw news media stories and videos of the fires in California. If we didn't see the stories in the news, we definitely choked on the smoke. Yet, we see no outrage or mass appeal for help. (There is one, but it just hasn't got a lot of attention out here.) I think it's too hard for us to imagine. How could one imagine hundreds of thousands of acres of land engulfed, over 1,000 homes destroyed, and hundreds more structures and businesses destroyed. It is unimaginable.

Given the conditions we see in fields in northwestern Minnesota right now, that could happen here. Be careful. Until widespread significant rain is received, the fire danger will continue to climb.

We all have dreams, but not all of us follow them. It takes a lot of work and a bit of courage to pursue your dreams. The final result of a dream typically looks obvious, but chances are there was a lot of legwork and risk-taking to arrive at that point.

Handmade items created by family, which had little use, had to bid for space with essential things like a coffee maker. It made me really see what Noah was up against when he loaded the ark.

I enjoy cleaning things out, not so much the work as the feeling of accomplishment. It just feels like you've really changed the world when you clean something out and arrange it. Friends and family boxed nick-knacks and memories protected by bubble wrap while

Mike, Joel and I arranged them in the moving truck.

Deb and Mike closed on their new home in North Carolina. We have a cousin there who has been the anchor for arranging things on the east end of this change in life. Deb and Mike already have friends there, too, so it isn't like they just got off the boat. It is one big change, however.

I wondered what this meant to me. The experience made me feel kind of uplifted and not because I wanted Deb and Mike gone! I think it was the excitement of the experience of watching someone change their life. To create this dream, doing the work to make it happen and having the courage in case it would fail was something I watched and admired. My vantage point made me think that many things are possible and important. I don't plan any geographic movement, but change comes in different forms. It was good to see one before I perform my own.

I do have several recipes from readers, so if you sent me one, don't worry. I'm going to use them one of these days. Also, if you phoned me and didn't get an answer, it might be because "Somebody" likes to push the "delete" buttons when he or she shouldn't and I've lost some interesting stuff that way. Now for today's recipes. They are from my slow cooker booklet. I love slow cooking, especially in summer (no fussing!).

### SLOW COOKER CHICKEN

6 boneless chicken breast halves  
1 can cream of mushroom soup  
1 package dry mushroom soup mix  
Approximately one-half cup sour cream  
4 ounce can mushrooms, drained

Combine chicken and soups in slow cooker. Cover and cook one low for 6 to 8 hours.

Just before serving, stir in soups, cream and mushrooms. Reheat briefly. Serve over noodles.

### GERMAN POTATO SALAD

4 to 6 cups sliced potatoes  
1/2 cup onions, chopped  
1/2 cup celery, sliced  
1/4 cup green peppers, diced  
1/4 cup vinegar  
2 tablespoons sugar  
1/4 cup oil

Chopped parsley  
Sliced bacon (cooked and crumbled)

Combine all ingredients except parsley and bacon. Add salt and pepper to taste. Stir and cook for 5 to 7 hours in a slow cooker.

Garnish with bacon and

parsley.

### POT ROAST

3 to 4 pounds boneless beef chuck roast  
1 cup sliced celery  
1 cup chopped onion  
1 can tomato soup or cream of mushroom soup (condensed)  
1 tablespoon vinegar  
2 tablespoons beef bouillon  
2 tablespoons dried sage leaves, crushed  
1/4 teaspoon pepper  
1/2 cup cold water  
1/3 cup flour

Trim fat from meat and place in slow cooker. Cut in half as needed to fit. Add celery and onion.

In bowl, stir soup, vinegar, bouillon, sage and pepper and pour into slow cooker.

Cover and cook on high for 4-1/2 to 5 hours or on low from 9 to 10 hours.

In bowl, stir water and flour until smooth. Stir into boiling liquid around roast.

Cook on high for 20 to 30 minutes. Transfer to warm platter and serve gravy separately.

### SPICE PUNCH

2 quarts apple cider  
2 cups cranberry juice  
2 tablespoons mixed whole spices: allspice, cloves, orange and ginger  
2 to 3 inches cinnamon sticks, broken  
Lemon or orange slices studied with whole cloves

Pour cider and juice into slow cooker. Place mixed spices in muslin bag or tea ball. Add to ball and add juice.

Cover and simmer on low for 2 hours.

Float cinnamon sticks and fruit slices in individual mugs as you serve.

## Pennington SWCD hosts well water testing clinic

Next week, the Pennington Soil Water and Conservation District will sponsor a well water testing clinic. Homeowners wanting their private well water tested for nitrates, E. coli, and total coliform bacteria may pick up sample bottles at the SWCD office Monday, Aug. 27 through Wednesday, Aug. 29, between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

The water sample must be collected Thursday, Aug. 30 and returned to the SWCD by 4:30 p.m. Samples are sent to a certified lab for analysis. The Pennington SWCD will pay 50 percent of the cost; homeowners are responsible to pay \$10 at the time they pick up their sample bottles. Due to a limited number of bottles, it will be handing them out on a first-come-first-serve basis.

The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) recommends that private wells be tested once a year to detect possible problems with bacterial contamination.

Coliform bacteria: are indicators of the sanitary quality of your water and are present in the wastes of warm blooded animals. They can be found in the soil, but usually not more than a few feet below the surface. When they are detected in well water it means that surface contamination may have entered the well. It also means that disease organisms from human and animal waste may be present.

E. coli is a more specific bacteria species that normally lives in the intestines of healthy humans and animals. If a sample is positive for E. coli, the water is contaminated with fecal matter. Most varieties of E. coli are harmless or cause relatively brief illness, but a few strains can cause severe health effects including abdominal cramps and vomiting.

Nitrates: Testing for nitrates are recommended every one to two years - more often if nitrates have been detected previously in the well, or if an infant under the age of six months will be consuming the water. Nitrates in well water are a health concern primarily for young infants in whom the nitrate can be converted into nitrite in the digestive tract. The nitrite then interferes with the ability of the baby's blood to carry oxygen, resulting in methemoglobinemia - or "blue baby syndrome."

Pennington SWCD sponsors well screening clinics with discounted prices each year. However, sample bottles are available at full price year-round. If you would like more information or have any questions about the clinic, please contact Peter Nelson, Water Plan coordinator, at 218-683-7075. ## 13th Annual Lions Fishing Tournament held today

### No-wake zone in effect north of Long's Bridge

The 13th Annual Thief River Falls Lions Club Fishing Tournament will be held today (Saturday, Aug. 18) from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on the Red Lake and Thief Rivers in and around Thief River Falls.

This year, anglers should be aware of a blue-green algae bloom near the Thief River Golf Club on the Thief River. Blue-green algae is toxic and it has led the Pennington County Board of Commissioners to establish a no-wake zone from Long's Bridge heading north to the county line.

The ordinance states: "Watercraft are now only allowed to be operated at the 'slowest possible speed necessary to maintain steerage, but in no case greater than 5 mph.'"

The temporary ordinance is in effect immediately and until Thursday, Nov. 1 unless sooner modified.

Responding to the County Board ordinance Tuesday, Lion Mike Reishus stated that anglers will be allowed to fish north of Long's Bridge and registered boats will be allowed to fish north of Long's Bridge.

"We will communicate that the County has established a No Wake Zone north of Long's Bridge," Reishus said. "We will discuss it in our rules meeting, during boat check in and each person fishing will receive a flyer telling them there is a no wake zone north of Long's Bridge."

The 2018 Lions Fishing Tournament begins with a mandatory rules meeting to be held at 8:30 a.m. at the Huck Olson Memorial Civic Center.

First prize of \$1,000 to be paid for the largest fish caught in three different categories: Walleye, Northern and Other. Places second through 10th will win cash or rod and reel combos. All participants over the age of 18 that weigh in a fish will have a chance to win \$38,000 towards the purchase of a new vehicle at Northern Motors by playing High Five Money Bags.

Live weigh-in will be done at the Huck Olson Civic Center beginning at 3:30 p.m., with an awards ceremony and the annual raffle conducted at 5 p.m.

Registration forms are available at Ace Hardware and Edward Jones-Pat Thibert in Thief River Falls or on www.trflions.org. Cost is \$30 per fisherman and \$10 per child 12 and under. A limited number of boat passes are available for \$5.

Proceeds from the raffle and fishing tournament are used for continuing improvements at Lions Park in Thief River Falls and various Lions Club projects and donations.

(Continued from Page 1) the Mud River looked normal near Grygla; however, two dogs drank water from the river and later died. Necropsies determined both dogs died from exposure to blue-green algae.

Thief River Falls Mayor Brian Holmer encouraged commissioners to approve the temporary ordinance here. Saying he wished the ordinance were permanent, Holmer referred to safety and erosion issues.

Blue-green algae was found Friday, July 14 in the Thief River. Blue-green algae can release toxins that are dangerous to humans and pets. People can become sick if they swallow, have

skin contact with, or breathe in airborne water droplets of the harmful algae while engaged in recreational activities in the water. According to the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency, those symptoms may include vomiting, diarrhea, rash, eye irritation, cough, sore throat and headache. Symptoms may begin two hours to two days after exposure.

Pets may also be affected. They may experience vomiting, diarrhea, weakness, difficulty breathing and seizures. In some instances, pets have died from ingesting or coming into contact with blue-green algae.

After the discovery, the city of Thief River Falls

closed the beach at Bill LaFave Park. It remains closed. The RLWD posted signs at boat access points on the Red Lake River in Thief River Falls and at parks near the river. Those signs were removed after the latest test results.

The MPCA noted that it is impossible to remove a blue-green algae bloom from a water body. Since the temperature of the river can't be controlled, the MPCA suggests reducing the amount of nutrients flowing into the river, including the amount of phosphorous and nitrogen from such sources as lawn fertilizer and runoff.

(Continued from Page 1) Ashwinn, an Ojibwe woman. The same year, the American Fur Company folded. Bonga continued to work as a trader and opened a lodge on Leech Lake with his wife.

Bonga frequently guided white immigrants and traders through the region. He often worked as an advocate for the Ojibwe in their dealings with trading companies and the government. Bonga monitored annuity payments and wrote letters on behalf of the Ojibwe, complaining to the state government about individual Indian agents in the region. Bonga's name appears as translator on a 1867 treaty between whites and Ojibwe at White Earth. He died at Leech Lake in 1874.

### Other activities

Saturday, Aug. 25 will close out with Mass at 5 p.m. The Louisville Foundation will sponsor a French supper (\$10 donation requested) and a dance at the American Legion in Red Lake Falls at 8 p.m.

On Sunday, Aug. 26, Corey Medina, Native American blues artist, and The Brothers of Bemidji will be on stage at 1:30 p.m. They combine storytelling with blues, rock and folk music.

At 2:30 p.m., hip-hop artist "Thomas X" Barrett and Brendan Strong will lead a program featuring poetry, Ojibwe hand-drum and flute playing, singing and youth dancers from Red Lake. Barrett, who is making an encore appearance at the festival, helped form Rez Rap Records in Red Lake to

teach Ojibwe youth the power of language and heritage.

Throughout the weekend, artists and artisans will demonstrate wool spinning and carding, butter making, yarn dyeing, broom and bowl making and woodworking.

Food, including French Festival specialties such as Tourtiere (meat pie) and bread made in the earth oven, will be available. Silent auctions will be held Saturday and Sunday.
