

Pick a problem and solve it

Sixty-two seniors at Lincoln High School maintained a 3.50 grade point average over all four years of their career at Lincoln High School. On Monday, May 1, the students were honored at the Lincoln High School 2023 Senior Honors Banquet.

Lincoln High School Principal Scott Brekke told the students they will always be part of the Prowler family. Brekke noted that there were 21 seniors in this class with a 4.0 grade point average. In his 23-year career, he has never had as many students with a 4.0 grade point average.

Three awards were presented during the banquet. The American Legion Scholarship was presented to Isaac Mauch. The American Legion Auxiliary Scholarship was presented to Stephanie Dagg. The Thief River Falls Times and Marvin Lundin Scholarship (formerly the You Write Real Good Award) was presented to Johanna Mattson.

During the banquet, three students spoke to the challenges they faced during their school years. Ava Delage, who said she has been extremely competitive all her life, said she learned not to fear failure and to be OK with her weaknesses.

Carli Prickett said her experiences shaped her into the person she is today. She said she learned through having to end her high school volleyball career in her junior year that sometimes the best decision isn't always the easiest.

Coby Skjerven said he learned that we all have our own paths to follow, and that though his path was hard, being authentic and open to others was important. The biggest growth, he said,

sometimes happens when you're vulnerable and uncomfortable.

Kurt Reynolds, an English teacher tasked with the job of responding to the students, noted that all of the students addressed the challenges they had to overcome during their school years.

Reynolds encouraged the students to take ownership of the problems they face. He talked about downstream problem solving which involves reacting to problems after they've occurred, while an upstream approach aims to prevent problems after they've occurred.

He praised the students for their achievements and knowledge, and challenged them to solve some of the problems that his generation may have created. "You're way too smart and talented to not be able to solve a problem, so pick one and solve it."

His final words to the students were to encourage them to thank the people who matter the most to them for supporting them through their high school experience. "It will not only be a gift to them, but a gift to you."

Other speakers included Mark Schmitke, manager of community relations and events at Digi-Key, which sponsored the event; Dr. Paula Henry, interim superintendent of schools in Thief River Falls; and, Ryan Walseth, chair of the Board of Education in Thief River Falls.

Schmitke, a graduate of Lincoln High School, encouraged students to take what they've learned and put it into practice.

Walseth encouraged the students to keep up the hard work because if they do, they will see wonderful things happen. "Students like you make me proud to be a Prowler," said Walseth.

Walseth also noted that this class was the first class in Thief River Falls to have participated in all-day, every day kindergarten in the District.

Henry told students that as they embark on the next phase of their lives to prepare for being servant leaders. Preparing for this leadership role can be enhanced in four ways - heart, head, hands and habit. Henry said heart means finding your why and way. Head means leading through the lessons and beliefs you learned from family and friends. Hands means applying what they've learned and putting it into action; and habit means doing what keeps them on track.

She congratulated the students on their achievement and said like her, their families were very proud of them.

A teacher that truly made an impact in my life is Mr. Froiland. Funny enough, I only had Mr. Froiland as a teacher once - in 10th grade for Algebra 2, and I don't recall being the biggest fan of the class either. I struggled with that class because it was mostly on Zoom and I don't like math in general, but Mr. Froiland taught me that I can do hard things, and trust me, his class was hard! I remember crying on

the last day of that class because I was so proud of myself for pushing through it even when I wanted to give up, and I was so grateful that Mr. Froiland helped me understand math a little better too. Although there is no doubt Froiland is an amazing teacher, that isn't why I chose to write about him. The biggest impact he made on me was at a time when I wasn't even his student.

It was my junior year of high school when I decided

to quit the sport that I have loved my whole life. I was in a horrible mental state and dealing with continuous injuries, so I chose to not go out for basketball. It was one of the hardest decisions I have ever had to make, and I felt like I didn't have an identity anymore once I quit. I remember walking through the halls one day on the verge of tears because I felt so isolated and lonely. I was so sick of hearing the same questions over and over again. "Why did you quit?" "Do you regret it?" "You were so good, it's a shame you quit." I was at a breaking point and I almost called my mom to let me leave school when Mr. Froiland pulled me aside in the hallway. I probably seemed super crabby because I didn't want to hear another person say the same things I had been hearing for weeks. To my surprise, he said the one thing I had been waiting to hear for a long time. He asked me: "How are you doing, are you OK?" I almost burst into tears, and I don't even remember what I said to him. I'm sure I kept it short and said I'm fine, but those words meant the world to me at that time. I was so thankful that someone had cared enough about me to ask not if I regretted my decision, but how I was doing at that time. I think this shows Mr. Froiland's character perfectly and how much he cares for the stu-

dents at our school. Even though I hadn't really talked to him since I was in his class the previous year, he still showed that he cared about how I was doing and not just as a student.

This year, after my latest concussion, I decided to be done playing sports and that was an extremely difficult decision, but it was the right one. Sure enough, Mr. Froiland came up to me and asked me, "Are you at peace?" I replied confidently that I was OK, and at peace with my situation. This just reinforced what I already knew about Mr. Froiland, that he cares about his students and always will. I think that it takes a special person, or specifically, a teacher, to make sure kids are doing OK not only in school, but also in their personal lives. I think every teacher should take after Mr. Froiland and learn to ask the simple question, "Are you OK?" He probably didn't know the impact that question would have on me, but it helped me so much just knowing someone cared about how I was doing. I think that is something everyone can make more of an effort to do. Teaching is about more than how your students are doing in the classroom. It's about making connections with them outside of it, and that's when the real learning can begin.

I hope that in whatever my future career is, I care enough about my students or patients to ask them how they are doing. Not just how they are doing in school or in their health, but how they are doing as a person. I think everyone should strive to be more like Mr. Froiland, I know I do, and he is someone who has truly inspired me!
